Procedures for a
Safe Return to
Church

CHECK-IN



If you do not feel well, then do not attend worship.



If you intend to worship, check in at the check-in station outside the church.



Before you arrive at the check-in table, please put on your mask.

At the check-in table:



sign the attendance sheet verifying that you do not have any of the established symptoms of COVID-19 and that you have not been in the presence of someone with the virus;



use the hand sanitizer at the check-in station;



take a bulletin.



Should you get ill after worship, please contact the office, so that others in attendance could be contacted and monitored.



CHURCH SERVICE



Every other pew will be available for seating. Do not sit in a “reserved sign” pew. Ushers will seat you.



Families that live in the same household can sit together in one pew.



Other than families, there will be up to 3 people per pew. Please observe the 6 foot rule, unless sitting with your family.



The service will last no more than 50 minutes. Only the Pastor will officiate in the service.



There will be an offering plate on the floor next to the organ as you enter the sanctuary and one on the collection table in the overflow area.

COMMUNION



The distribution of Communion will be the end of the service. For the distribution, the Pastor will be masked and gloved.



Keeping your hand open, the Pastor will drop the host into your hand. Do not grab it from him.



The Pastor will extend the cup to you. Receive it from the bottom.



After drinking the wine, place the disposable cup in the receptacle that will be set up next to the Pastor.



Communion distribution will be the continuous line that we use during intinction. Maintain social distance as you stand in line.
